

August 2017 Monthly Report Repairers of the Breach Medical Clinic

In the month of August, our clinic will be open for a total of **17 days**. As of today's report, we have been open for **13 days** and have served **69 patients**. Of the 4 days remaining in the month, one day will be a breast health clinic. We will see approximately 80 to 90 patients this month. To date, we welcomed **14** new patients.

Our devoted volunteers have donated **218 hours** of their time and talent with a monetary value of **\$11,319.96**. They have provided help to **11 diabetics** in a little more than a month providing education and life-saving medication. They have also seen **18 patients** to treat or monitor hypertension. Our volunteers have been instrumental in the education of our future physicians, nurses, and physician assistants through the medical care experience that they offer. External volunteers provided **23 hours** of dedicated time valued at **\$575.00**. Our in-kind donations totaled **\$19,300.00**. Donations included medication, oral health supplies, and miscellaneous items. A special thanks to Jerry Gantner, one of our special volunteers who was instrumental in arranging a donation from the Gilbert Petsky Fund for **\$19,000.00**. This donation will help many of our patients receive access to the medications that they need to thrive and survive.

Our clinic belongs to a network of free clinics on the local, state, and national levels. We share resources and communicate on an on-going basis to better serve our patients. One of the clinic's main purposes is to prevent unnecessary trips to over-burdened hospital emergency rooms. If there is a service that we cannot provide, we often locate a clinic in the network who can. Repairers is one of a handful of clinics that is free standing and services patients free of charge whether they have insurance or not.
