All guests attending also receive a free souvenir book and free admission to the galleries. Grohmann Museum staff will provide a brief tour of the museum to those interested, as well as a visit to the private rooftop office of Dr. Eckhart Grohmann, the museum’s founder. His office is inside the cupola atop the building’s glass-walled atrium.

Weather permitting, guests can also spend time in the rooftop sculpture garden. The Grohmann Museum is on the Milwaukee School of Engineering campus in downtown Milwaukee (Building “G” at the corner of N. Broadway and State Street on the MSOE campus map below). **Free parking** is available in the MSOE State Street A, B, and C Lots. There is also free two-hour street parking on Saturdays.
