



## Board of ROTB Medical Clinic 'September 2024' Statistics

### Monthly Report Summary

The Medical Clinic at Repairers of the Breach was open during the month of **September** providing free medical care to patients for **14 days clinic was open for the reporting month'**. In those 14 days we were able to provide quality health services to **77 patients in September** compared to **August (69 patients, 14 clinic days)**. Of the patients seen this month, **27** were new and being seen for the first time. At our clinic, **47** identified as being male, and **30** patients identified as being female. Over **68%** of the patients seen in our clinic during the month of September identified as being unhoused.

The students and instructors of Marquette & MSOE, along with Physicians and Registered Nurses, staffed our medical clinic this month. Our clinic volunteers, faculty, and students graciously donated an incredible total of **242.8** hours of their time, which has a monetary value of **\$7,455.67**. Our external volunteers contributed **9.00** hours of their time, at a monetary value of **\$225.00**

In addition to the generous gift of time, were fortunate to receive medical donations, mostly medications, diabetic testing supplies, allergy medication total monetary value of **\$3,167.23**
